Let the Celebration Begin! Wild Hog Approaches 35 Years

The Hog will turn 35 on November 30. But we will start festivities early with a concert by two men from Milwaukee who have graced the Hog stage over the years with their music.

Lil Rev and Larry have been friends for more than 25 years. They have a CD entitled <u>Around The Campfire</u> and have been performing together off and on for the last couple of years.

Rev is an award-winning multi-instrumentalist, singer-songwriter, and music historian who teaches nationally and travels widely across the continental United States. In addition to his wonderful voice, his instruments include mandolin, banjo, harmonica, guitar and ukulele. He has won a national harmonica championship. He connects with his audiences by performing songs they can relate to, telling stories and reading poems.

Larry plays guitar, sings and tells stories of hard work, working people, trains, trucks, life on the road, love, nonsense and flamingos. He was a truck driver. Noted for their elegance in simplicity, his songs are popular not only with audiences, but are acclaimed by other artists, many of whom have recorded their own renditions of Larry's songs. His performances have delighted audiences from age 3 to 103 at schools, museums and festivals from the Hobo Festival in Britt, Iowa to the Musica E. Livorno in Torino, Italy.
